

IT'S A FACT



It's a Fact is our latest program designed for schools going through this Covid Pandemic. It allows students and teachers to listen to knowledgeable safety speakers, to watch a targeted video presentation while observing safety protocols as set down by your school district.

It's a Fact utilizes students by giving them (through their teachers) the responsibility of organizing students into groups that will come out of the school to the display Accident Awareness has set up. They will arrange the students so that they will be socially distant from other students while at the same time be able to see and hear the

speaker.

Each outdoor presentation will take approximately 20 minutes from start to finish. The display will consist of the crash vehicle mounted on a trailer attached to our pickup truck. It will be barriered off. Students and teachers can get up close to the vehicle to check out the damage both outside and inside the vehicle.

Near this display we have a 55 inch all weather monitor in an(right) enclosure to shield it from the sun or rain. The presentation will be short, approximately 10 or 11 minutes in length, will include specific subjects as seen below and will do it in a matter of fact, no nonsense way that students will understand.

After the presentation, viewers will have the opportunity to examine the crash vehicle which is tied into the topic being discussed at the outdoor presentation. Students will then return to their class and the next group will come out.



Subjects to be addressed to grade 9's and 10's

- Pedestrian Impact
- Seat Belts
- Being a passenger in a street race/stunt driving incident
- Being a passenger in a vehicle operated by person intoxicated by alcohol/drugs
- How to get safely out of a moving vehicle when feeling unsafe due to driver actions.

Topics for grades 11 and 12

- The Pedestrian Impact
- Seat Belts
- Street Racing/Stunt Driving
- Distracted Driving
- Intoxicated by alcohol or drugs
- How to get safely out of a moving vehicle when feeling unsafe due to driver actions (good for all to know).

It should be noted here that this is the most adaptable and versatile program **Accident Awareness** has ever offered. It takes up a minimum amount of time for students and teachers, has targeted points that can be changed at any time, adheres to pandemic restrictions and school board regulations.

And it is worth noting again that student involvement brings with it responsibility and leadership, two great qualities for students of all ages.

This is the perfect time of year for outdoor events like ours to take place.
